NIEPID is dedicated to providing quality services to Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (Divyangjan) in the National interest. The training programmes are offered on a gradual scale from certificate - diploma - undergraduate - graduate - postgraduate - Masters Levels. Presently, the Institute conducts 2 Certificate Course, 3 Diploma Courses (D.Ed SE (IDD), DVR, DISLI and DECSE). Further, two Graduate course (B.Ed Spl. 1. Abstract Content

- Abstract must be written in English
- The content should be original and not previously published or presented.
- Avoid using tables, figures, or references in the abstract.

2. Format and Structure

- Title: concise and accurately reflects the content (max 20 words).
- Authors: List all contributing authors with affiliations.
- Do not include author names or affiliations in the body of the abstract.
- Body: maximum 300 words.
- Structure :
 - a. Background / Objectives
 - b. Methods
 - c. Results
 - d. Conclusion

3. Submission Process

- Submit abstracts electronically via email.
- Only one abstract per presenting author is allowed.
- All submissions must be received by the stated deadline.

4. Review and Notification

- All abstracts will be peer-reviewed by the scientific committee.
- Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent via email by the specified date.
- Accepted abstracts may be selected for oral or poster presentation.
